"Low Carbon Sheep Farming: from Innovation to Practice" is a dissemination event of the mid-term results of the SheepToShip LIFE project.

- SheepToShip LIFE is a five-year project (July 2016 - July 2021), co-funded by the EU LIFE Programme 2014-2020, which aims to reduce by 20% in 10 years the greenhouse gas emissions of the sheep dairy sector in Sardinia, through the identification and application of eco-innovative techniques.

- The Web Conference aims to take stock of the progress of the project and to contribute to the debate on rural development strategies, aimed at promoting the environmental sustainability of sheep production systems. In particular, the event will propose a comparison on the key instruments of the National Strategic Plan for Rural Development (NSP) 2021-2027, with the purpose of assessing the replicability of the replicability of the SheepToShip LIFE best practice proposals at both national and European scales.

After sharing the experiences from SheepToShip LIFE project, the conference will focus on a range of themes: the NSP and the potential impacts of the rural development instruments on the sheep farming supply chain in Sardinia, the technical and scientific dimension (CNR, UNISS and Agris), and the political and institutional side at both regional (Departments of Agriculture and Environment of the Autonomous Region of Sardinia) and national levels (Council for Agricultural Research and Analysis of Agricultural Economics).

In addition, the director of the environmental evaluation service at *IDELE (Institut de l'Elevage, France)*, will talk about the lessons learned on Carbon Farming Schemes in France, illustrating the governance models they developed with the purpose of facilitating the adoption of climate-friendly practices in the agricultural and livestock sectors.
